

- **Job Title:** Assistant Herd Manager
- **Based at:** Brockman Farms - Montgomery, Texas

- **Job Purpose:**

Assist in the daily management and maintenance of a 200 sow show pig operation and 10-15 head boar stud.

- **Key Responsibilities and Accountabilities:**

1. Assist in feeding and caring for boars, sows, and babies on a daily basis (this includes daily assessment of general health, cleanliness, etc. see also point number 4.)
2. Clean and maintain facilities at both the main farm and isolation facility (washing out sow barn and boar pens daily, clean out chip pens when needed as well as mowing, shredding, and weed-eating as needed)
3. Assist in processing litters, vaccinating babies and sows, AIing, collecting boars, heat detection, farrowing, and medicating.
4. Prepare facilities for upcoming season (i.e., power wash farrowing house, nursery, chip barn, and all associated equipment; set up heat lamps, heaters, feeders, mats, etc. in each area as well.)
5. Assist with show pig sales and pig delivery.
6. Assist in repairs and maintenance of all facilities
7. Operating equipment such as skid steer, tractor, etc. for unloading feed trucks, cleaning, and other general necessities.

- **Hours:** Start at 7:30 am and work until all chores and tasks are completed for that day. Work Monday-Friday and every other weekend. "On call" during main farrowing and breeding seasons. We ask that you be flexible during busier seasons as needed.
- **Compensation:** Monthly salary, housing and all utilities provided, bonuses available.
